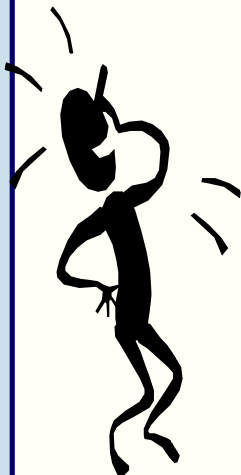
LAWYER JOKE

4-6 oz of diced, unsmoked bacon—as lean as possible

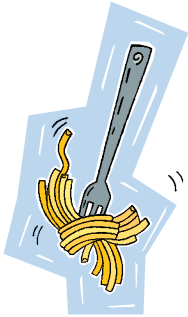
5 Tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
